\$5.00 per individual other entry

**Drop Fees:** Forfeiture or Entry Fee after 4:00 pm Wednesday, January 22nd

**Judging Requirements:** 1-6 entries 1 judge or pay \$50 fee  
\*We prefer you bring judges rather than pay fee. 7-12 entries 2 judges or pay \$75 fee  
Judging fees will be strictly enforced.

**Graders:** For each graded event entered, a school must provide at least one grader. Grading room will be located very close to the Hospitality room.

**Hospitality Room:** A wonderful hospitality room will be available for breakfast & lunch for all teachers and judges.

**Concession Stand:** A full concession stand will be available in the holding area for all students and coaches. Charge accounts can be set up through the person in charge at a later date.

**Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals and 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons to individuals. Plaques to 1<sup>st</sup> place teams. Trophy to Top School
