IMMUNIZATIONS GUIDELINES HASKELL CISD

Students enrolling from another Texas school:

The student may be enrolled and given a 30 day provisional enrollment while waiting for records from the previous school. If there are shots required when the record arrives, the student must get the needed shots immediately.

Students identified as **homeless** will also be given a 30 day provisional enrollment.

Students with missing shots at enrollment:

The student must get the needed immunization before enrolling.

Students enrolling from out of state or country:

Students must have a current record.

Students with missing shots and in the process of completing a series on schedule:

The student may enroll and must continue the immunizations on schedule.

Students enrolling from home school:

Students must have an up to date shot record for enrollment.

Students not enrolled in any school last semester:

The student must have a current shot record to enroll.

Currently enrolled students with an overdue immunization:

Students with overdue immunizations will not be enrolled. At the end of each school year parents will be informed about necessary immunizations for the next school year. Those needing immunizations during the summer must bring an updated record before beginning football practice, band practice, or before starting classes. For those needing immunizations during the school year, a final notice of **one week** will be given by phone or by mail if an updated record has not been received by the date needed. . The school nurse will inform the parent not to bring the student to school until the shot is given and a record of the shot is returned to the school. It is recommended that all students receive their immunizations during the summer to avoid unnecessary complications during the school year.

EXEMPTIONS

Students with a religious or conscientious exemption:

The parent must write to Austin for the form, have it notarized and bring to the school. A 90 day grace period is allowed.

Medical Exemptions must have a yearly note from a doctor (MD or DO) **unless** the note states it is a lifelong contradiction.

Conscientious and religious exemptions must be renewed every **2** years.

All conscientious and religious exemptions in place prior to 2004 are considered lifelong exemptions. All conscientious and religious exemptions must be notarized and on the correct State form. To obtain the correct form, write to the following address:

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS

DPT All Kindergarteners must have a least **4 doses**. One dose must be given after the 4th birthday. 5 doses are required when there is not one after the 4th birthday. **Tdap** booster is due 10 years after the date of the last shot.

POLIO All Kindergarteners must have **3 doses**. One does must be given after the 4th birthday. 4 doses are required when there is not one after the 4th birthday.

MMR All Kindergarteners are required to have **2 doses**. One dose must be given on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be given before kindergarten and at least 4 weeks from the first dose.

Hepatitis B All Kindergarteners are required to have **3 doses**.

Chickenpox All Kindergarteners are required to have **one dose** of vaccine or proof that they have had the disease. This verification must state the month and year the child had the chickenpox and must be signed and dated by the parent.

Note: Children in Pre-Kindergarten, Head Start, or PPCD are required to have HIB, Hepatitis A and Pneumococcal vaccinations. Students K – 12 are not required to have these vaccinations.
