

## SHAC Minutes April 29, 2026

The meeting was held at the Admin office and started at 5:32 pm. Present were M. Sunday, B. Lindsey, C. Gannaway, V. Shiplett, T. Smart, S. Gibson, E. Watson

Motion to approve last meeting minutes motioned by E. Watson and second by B Lindsey.

Discussed changing meeting time back to 5 pm for the next school year. We also discussed replacing the current parents on SHAC due being on the committee for 2 years or more. Asked for ideas for parents to ask to join, M. Sunday stated she talked with Sam Cedillo about joining next year. C Gannaway recommended Deshae Sorrells.

M. Sunday discussed energy drinks and passed out a flyer on the Effects of Energy drinks.

Discussed banning them from HS campus next school year, V. Shiplett stated they had taken one from a first grader. E. Watson also mentioned she has seen numerous JH students come into the cafeteria in morning with an energy drink. A vote was taken to ban Energy drinks from all campuses for students, vote for was 7, against 0. Will follow up with enforcing that next school year. V. Shiplett also stated she would like to not allow elementary students to bring soda drinks to school, this was second by T. Smart. Will also be in effect for 2026/2027 school year.

Discussed Walk across Texas and Haskell CISD has 5 teams participating - 40 employees and gave this week's standings with JH Hallway Hustlers in first. Also discussed M. Sunday went to Southern Faye nutrition and she will be donating 8 Teas to the first place team, and for the top walker in each group they will get a gift card, at this time Little Italy donated \$20 gift card and Shuggie Sweet shop also donated \$20 gift card. Kim Bob's saddle also stated they would donate something, the nurse will get over to them this week. Asked for ideas what other businesses would maybe donate, The Drug store, Missy's and Mi Familia was brought up.

Discussed Tucker's Law and M. Sunday talked about Texas A & M new program THINK SMART and how they teach and give the resources on the program to someone that is designated to teach it to JH and HS over 6 courses in the year. Will reach out to the Ladies at A&M that spoke at regional nurse meeting to come meet with counselors this summer. E. Watson spoke how she spoke with another counselor about Open Door program for sex ed., and she will be meeting with them May 28, 2026. It consists of 6-8 sessions where someone will come in and teach it, and the fee is free.

Last thing discussed was the possibility of having fundraisers next year to help SHAC with prizes for things like walk across Texas and to also help buy the 5th grade supplies for puberty class. V. Shiplett stated maybe the hospital could partner with the school and provide some items. E. Watson will reach out to Haskell Hospital and inquire about it.
